Thursday Crit Series (Pearl St Grill Series) – 2010 Andy Cummings and Frank Grillo instructed the following

Proposed budget which is preliminary and has not yet been put forth to sponsors;

Permits fees - \$7000.00

Race Official - \$1200.00

Toilets - \$3960.00

Equipment (possible chip timing) - \$10,200.00 this would be used for both the crit series and BBC races

Purses - \$23,000.00

- Have received approval from the City of Buffalo but permits have yet to signed off
- Have met with area sponsors and the budget needs to be worked out. Said sponsors are very excited about this venture.
- Corporate sponsorship at each of the 4 corners is being worked but outlook is very encouraging
- A proposed schedule of 20 events, 16 Thursday night and 4 Sunday events
- Due to the location, these races will be in the public eye. For this reason marshalls are key.

Although local groups will be helping out, BBC members are highly encouraged to also help. In total 2-3 Marshalls per corner, 1 for each parking lot and crossing guards will be needed.

- Prize money will be awarded at each race, because of this competitive permits are needed for each race. If a licensed official is present at a race then points towards category upgrades will also be included. Officials are to TBD.
- Fees are TBD but a discount for BBC members is possible and TBD
